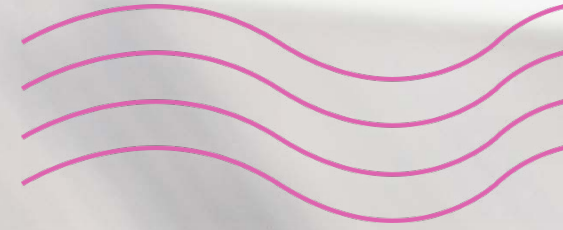


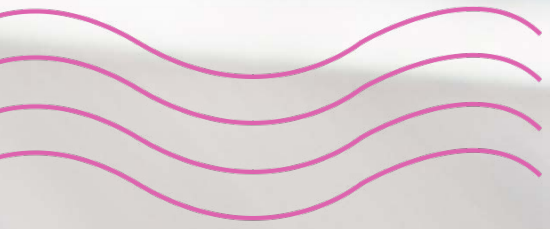
BACK TO SCHOOL CAMPAIGN

Each year in September, we host a Back to School Campaign to support our Justice Rising students and teachers. Living in conflict zones, many of our students and their families have fled from war or continue to live in communities with active conflict.

OUR SCHOOLS PROVIDE A QUALITY, CONFLICT-SENSITIVE EDUCATION, GIVING STUDENTS TOOLS TO CREATE A MORE PEACEFUL AND EQUITABLE FUTURE WHILE ALSO RESTORING A SENSE OF NORMALCY.

Sadly, due to challenges related to war, poverty, and trauma, many families are unable to afford school fees, uniforms, or books for their children to attend school, causing many kids to miss out on the chance at a good education.





This is where our Back to School Campaign comes in. Justice Rising's Peace Partners are a community of monthly donors committed to supporting students by helping to cover the cost of schooling each month, making a good education possible for all children regardless of circumstance. It costs just \$5/student each month to cover basic school fees, providing promising young people with the opportunity to have a brighter future.

WHAT IS A BACK TO SCHOOL AMBASSADOR?



A BACK TO SCHOOL AMBASSADOR IS A PERSON WHO ADVOCATES ON BEHALF OF OUR STUDENTS TO THEIR SPHERE OF INFLUENCE (E.G. FRIENDS, FAMILIES, AND NETWORKS) ABOUT THE CHALLENGES STUDENTS FACE GOING TO SCHOOL IN WAR ZONES,

but also the available opportunities to create generational impact through quality, conflict-sensitive education.

For the month of September, Ambassadors can partner with us by spreading awareness to help us reach our goal of supporting 500 new students through our monthly Peace Partner community.

This may look different for everyone. But, for example, you might want to say to your followers:

"I would like to see 100 students supported each month, which means we need 20 people to sign up as Peace Partners for \$25/month. Will you join me?"

With your support, we believe we can make an enormous impact on the lives of these promising students. We hope you'll join us in our mission to transform war zones through education!

A Peace Partner is a monthly donor who supports Justice Rising students each month, helping to provide a free or low-fee education.

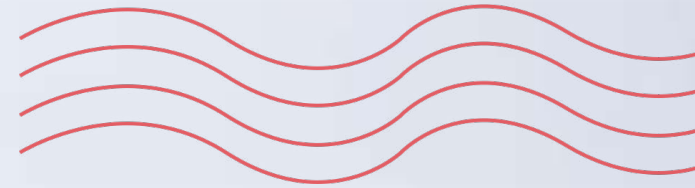
